If you are not ready for full residential care but require some assistance to continue to live well at home, KOPWA can provide in-Home Care services. The services you receive may include visits from a registered nurse, care worker, domestic support worker, or gardener.

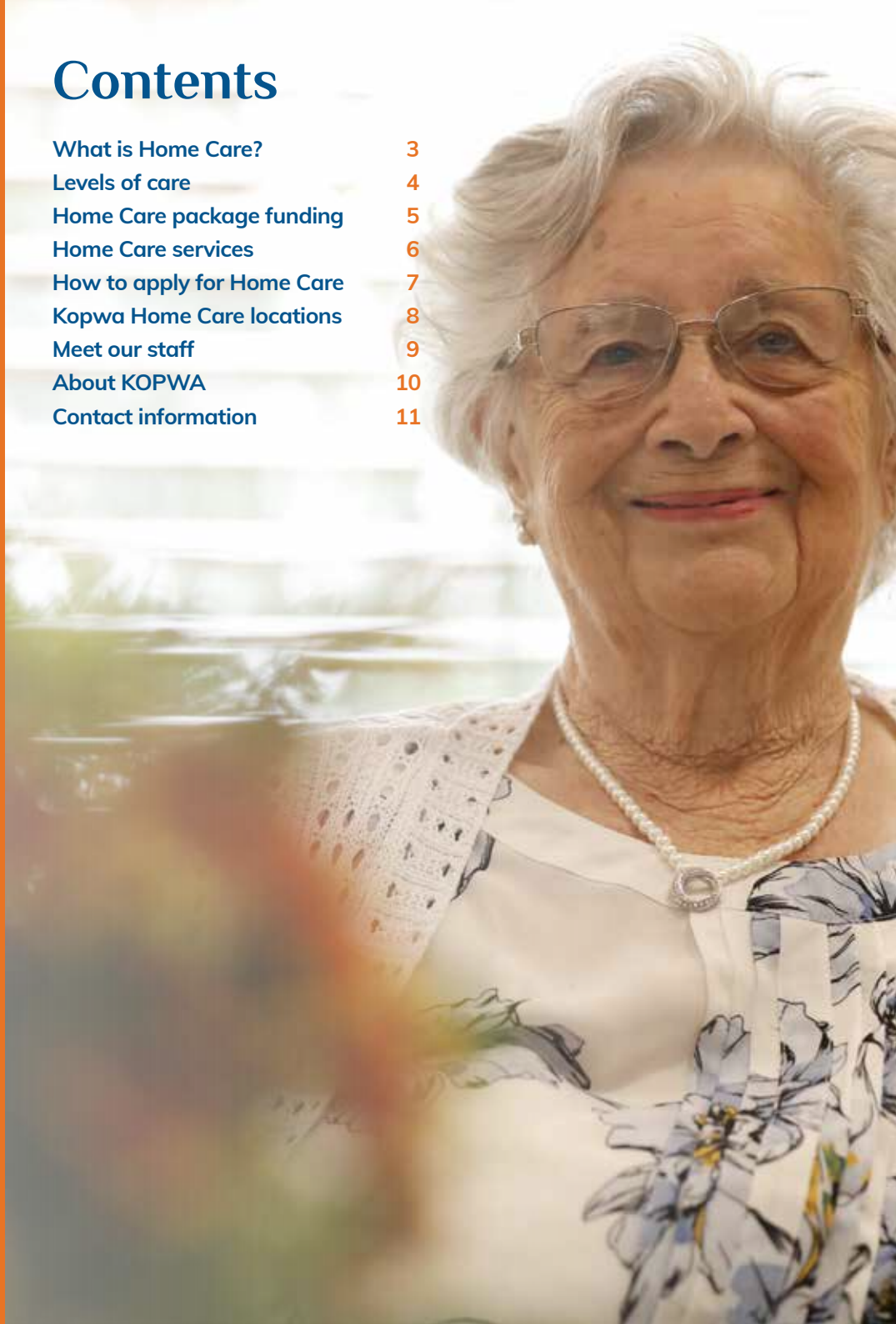
KOPWA can help assist with your eligibility for Home Care services as part of a free consultation. We will design a flexible package based on your requirements, wishes and continued life goals.

KOPWA cares

KOPWA means Keeping Older People Well At home. Founded in 1957, we are a not-for-profit organisation that is committed to supporting the needs of seniors who live at home.

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What is Home Care?

Home Care bridges the gap between living independently and relocating to a residential aged care facility.

It allows seniors to remain living in their home or retirement unit without the need for round-the-clock care, but provides peace of mind in the form of regular visits from a nurse or domestic care worker.

In addition to helping with personal hygiene and grooming, administering medication and wound care, Home Carers can look after household tasks like cleaning and doing laundry. They can also help in the garden, provide transport to and from social outings and even provide company for a cup of tea and a friendly chat.

In Australia, seniors over the age of 65 who find it difficult to look after their home and are struggling to manage personal care may be eligible for what's known as a Home Care package, which covers most of the cost of Home Care. Alternatively, you may decide to pay for Home Care as a private client.

Which level is right for you?

To determine the level of care you require, you will need to be assessed by ACAT (Aged Care Assessment Team). You can obtain a referral for assessment from your doctor or request an assessor visit you during a stay in hospital.

KOPWA can also arrange an assessment for you. After the assessment, you will be formally advised which Home Care package you are eligible for. From there, we can help you select the most appropriate Home Care services for your needs.

Levels of care

Home Care in Australia is broken into four levels. Each level has a capped annual budget and the services provided will be based on your personal requirements.

LEVEL 1 - Basic Care needs

- Personal Assistance (i.e. paying bills, organising home maintenance)
- Social support to keep you connected with family and friends
- Retail and/or grocery shopping
- Transportation
- Domestic assistance

LEVEL 2 - Low Care needs

- Personal Assistance (i.e. paying bills, organising home maintenance)
- Social support to keep you connected with family and friends
- Retail and/or grocery shopping
- Transportation
- Domestic assistance
- Supervision of medication

LEVEL 3 - Intermediate Care needs

- The same services as Levels 1 & 2
- Personal assistance (ie. Toileting, showering etc)
- Social outings
- Meal planning, preparation and supervision
- Allied Health services
- Organising support aids
- Respite care options

LEVEL 4 - High Care needs

- The same services as Levels 1 & 2
- Multi-level personal assistance
- Complex clinical nursing needs as required
- Medication prompt and supervision
- Meal planning, preparation and supervision
- Allied Health services
- Organising support aids
- Dementia care assistance
- Respite care options

Home Care Package fund

Home Care can be paid for as a private client or with the help of a Home Care package that is subsidised by the Australian government. You may be eligible for Home Care funding, even if you have an income outside of the pension. KOPWA Home Care can help you determine if you can access financial support or at Home Care. The amount of funding you receive depends on the level of care you qualify for and the amount of money you have.

Once you know this level of care, your contributions are broken into the following:

- **Government subsidy - Varies**
The cost of your Home Care package budget is likely to be subsidised by the government.
- **Income tested fee**
If you have income or assets, you may be required to contribute to the cost of your Home Care.
- **Additional fees - To be advised**
If you require care outside of the level you are assigned, you may need to pay extra for Home Care.

Your Home Care Package budget sets out the total amount of funds available for your use over the course of a year. The funds in your budget are used to cover the cost of care and services based on your care plan.

Self-funded care




Those who can afford to contribute to the cost of Home Care and are not eligible for Government support can pay per appointment or select an ongoing care package from KOPWA Home Care.

How to arrange Home Care with KOPWA

STEP 1

Undertake an Aged Care Assessment (ACAT) with My Aged Care. We will help you take the steps to arrange this.

STEP 3

Determine which level of Home Care you qualify for and how your Home Care will be paid for (e.g. privately funded/Government-subsidised)

STEP 4

Confirm the services that will be included as part of your Home Care package.

STEP 5

A KOPWA care worker will arrive at your home according to a set schedule.

Level 1: Basic

Betty enjoys living on her own and is generally in good health but is less mobile than she used to be. She receives weekly visits from a cleaner and a driver arrives to take her to and from her knitting club once a week.

'JIM & NORAH' | Aged 83 & 75

Level 2: Low

Jim struggles with mobility due to a leg injury and Norah has arthritis which can impact her ability to do things around the home. They receive visits from a cleaner and gardener, plus a housekeeper who helps to change bed linen and do the laundry.

'BILL & SALLY' | Aged 94 & 90

Level 3: Intermediate

Bill is in a wheelchair and Sally is not able to support all his needs. A nurse comes every other day to help Bill shower. Sally is currently speaking to KOPWA about arranging twice-daily help to get Bill in and out of bed.

'ANYA' | Aged 87

Level 4: High

Anya has difficulties with her short term memory. On the days her family members can't be with her, she receives visits from carers who prepare meals, ensure she takes her medication, help her to order groceries and make sure she is safe at home.
